Humanimal Trust was founded

- Establishment and development of solid foundations and infrastructure to support future sustainable growth for the Trust, along with a period of awareness raising activity as a key priority

2017

- PhD studentship launched: Bacteriophages as an alternative to antibiotics
- PhD studentship launched: Oncolytic viro-therapy as a cancer treatment
- Research study launched: Investigating the feasibility of animal assisted intervention in a children's clinical setting

2018

- Research study launched: Developing liquid cancer biopsies for canine patients - reciprocity in action
- Volunteer Ambassador programme launched
- Community talks programme launched

2019

- Humanimal Trust Pledge for One Medicine launched
- Research study launched: Understanding how osteosarcoma spreads
- Support for Action Medical Research studies begins:
 1. Preventing infections and reducing the risk of antibiotic-resistant infections in critically ill children.
 2. Juvenile idiopathic arthritis: personalising drug treatment
